

Landscape Painting!!

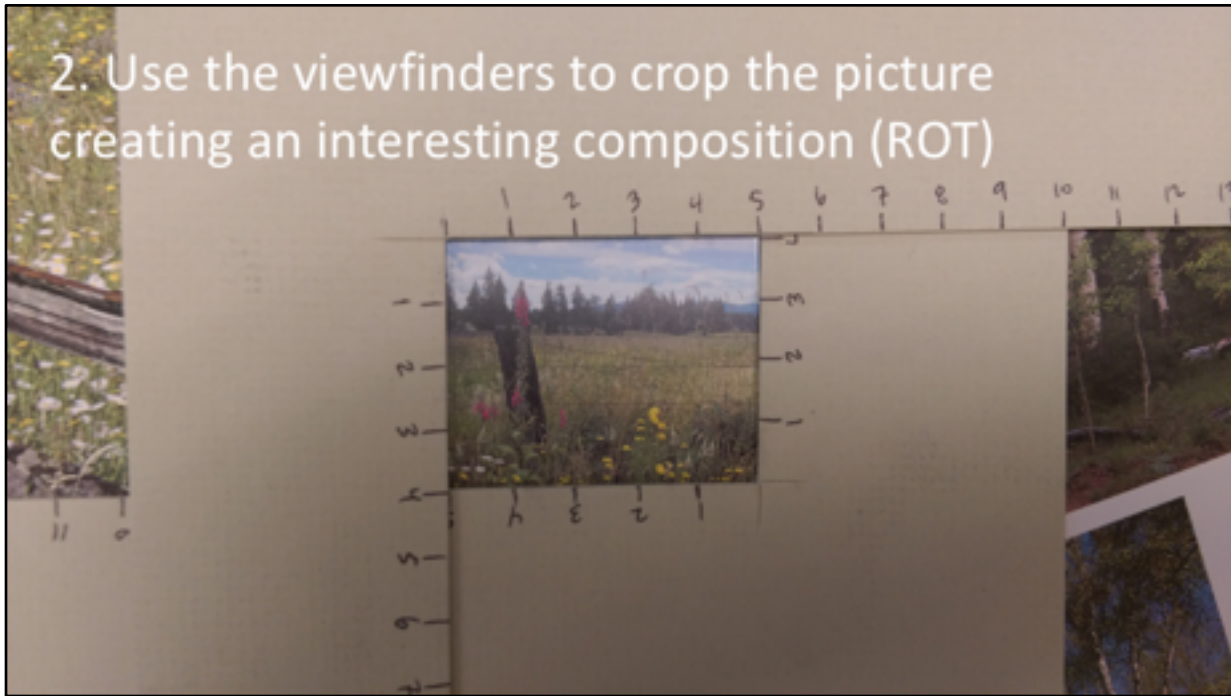
Landscape: "a picture representing a section of natural, inland scenery, as of prairie, woodland, mountains...an expanse of natural scenery seen by the eye in one view."



1. Select 3 landscape photos



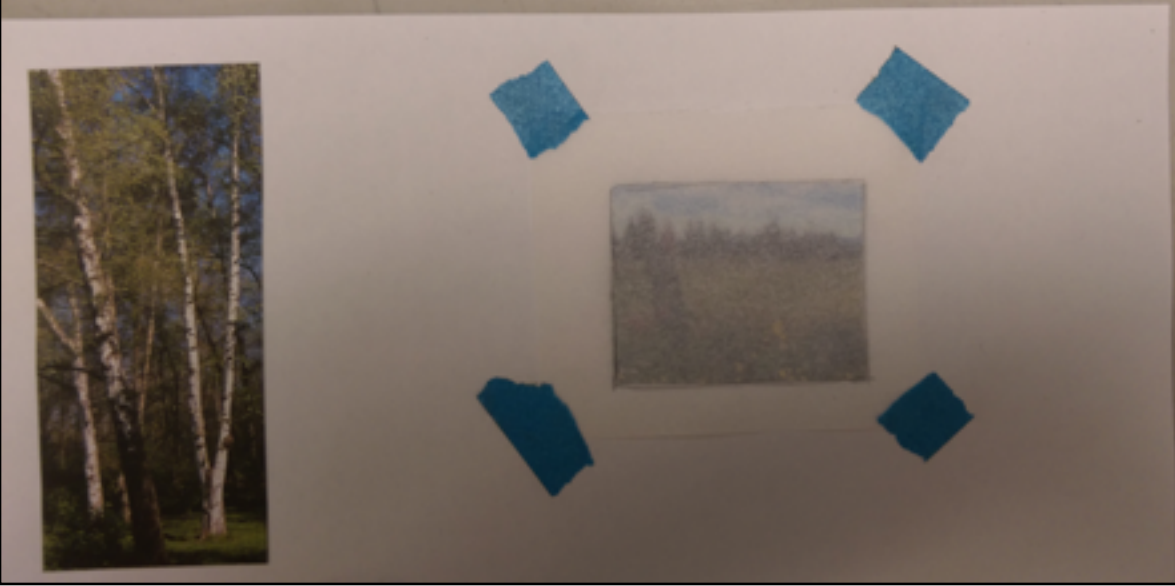
2. Use the viewfinders to crop the picture creating an interesting composition (ROT)



3. Draw a box on the picture with a pen/marker, cut it out with scissors

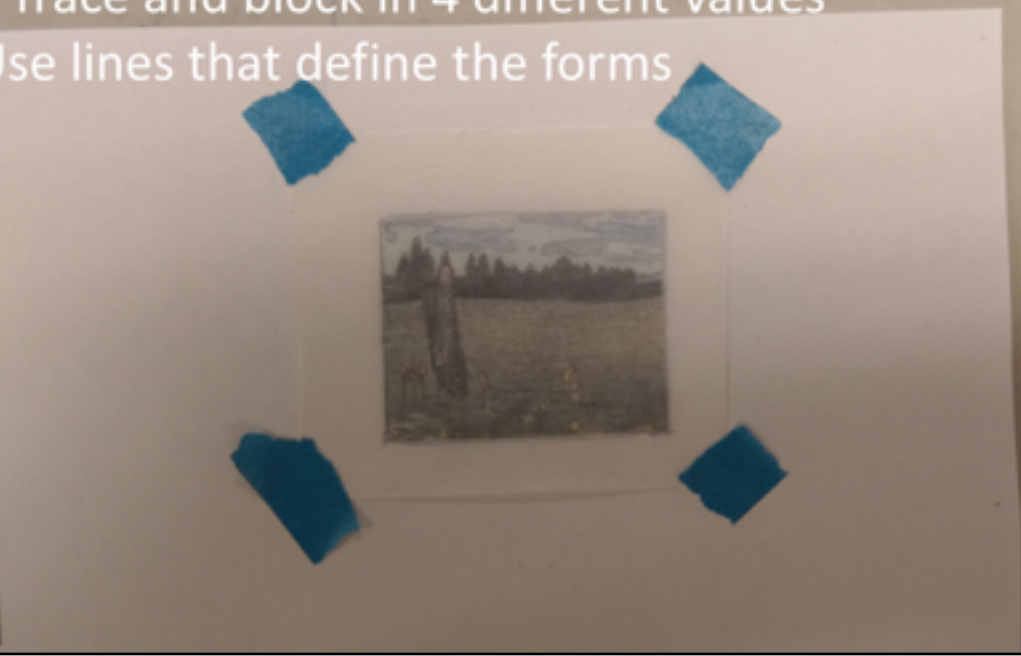


4. Tape tracing paper on top of each photo



5. Trace and block in 4 different values

-Use lines that define the forms



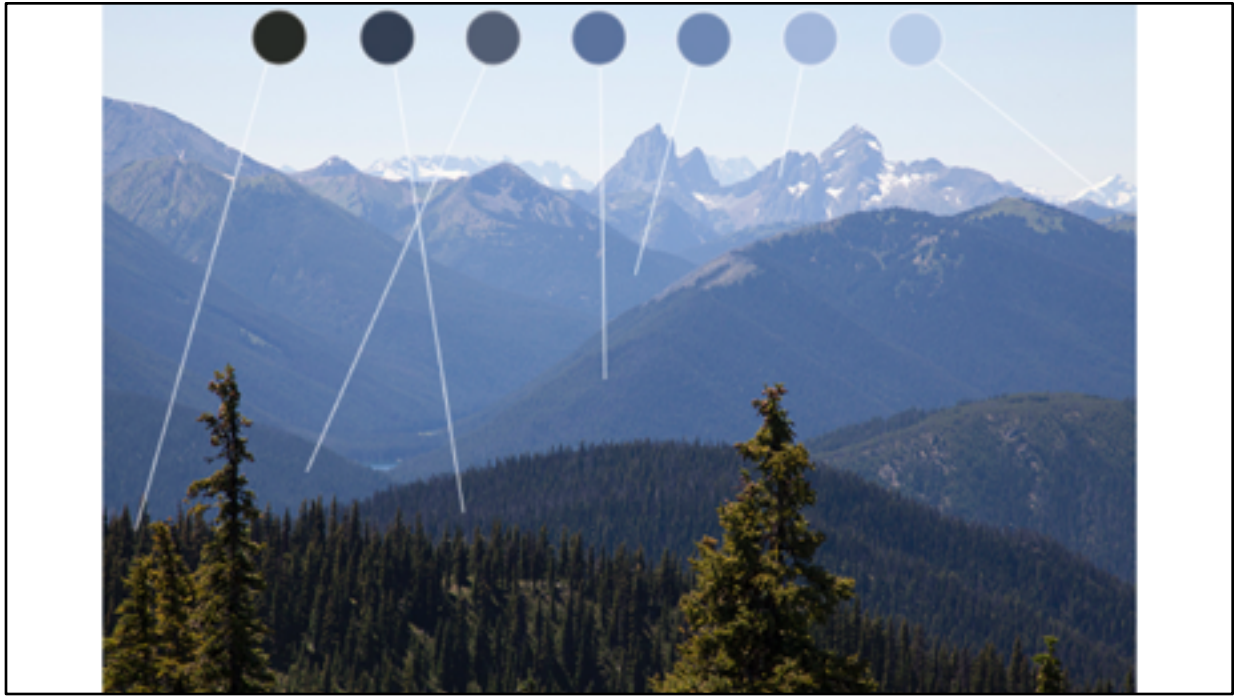
I can...

- Lead the eye to the foreground using 4 different values...
 - SKY- Lightest
 - HORIZONTAL GROUND PLANES- light grey
 - SLANTED PLANES (like ditches, rocks, hillsides)- dark grey
 - UPRIGHT ITEMS (like trees or buildings)- darkest value
- Use lines/brushstrokes to help define the forms (cross-contour lines)
- **Atmospheric Perspective-** The object loses intensity and lightens up as it gets further away in space

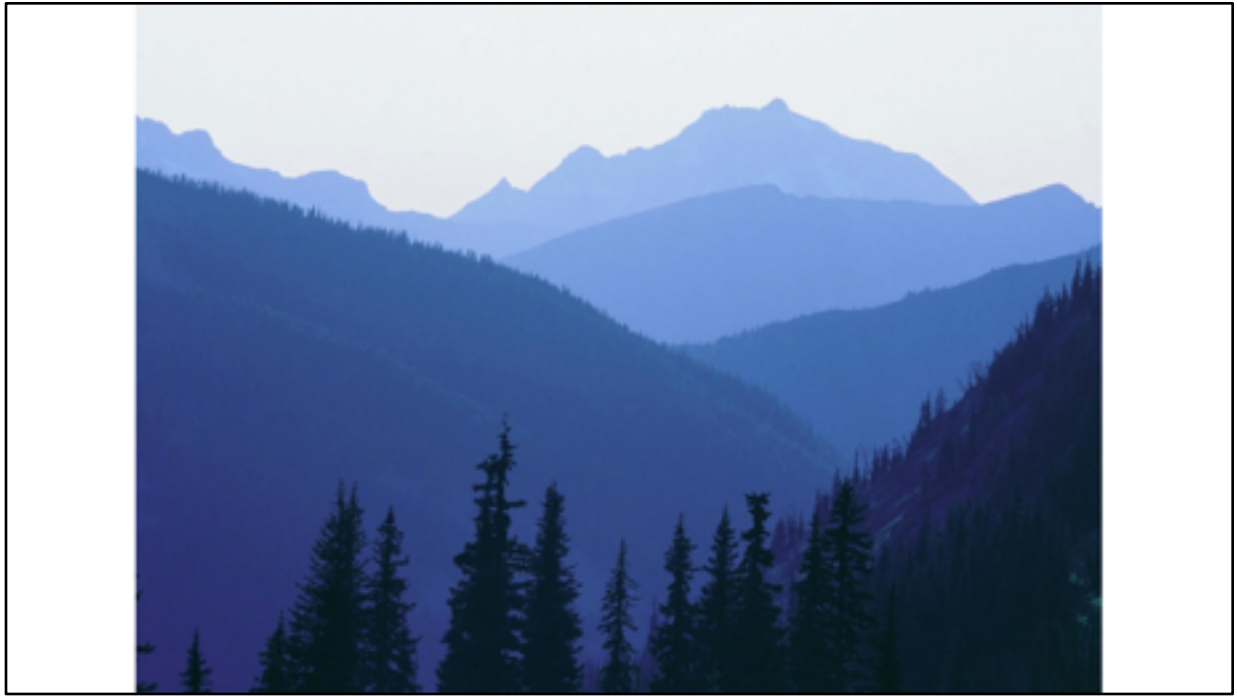




Impression, Sunrise by Claude Monet. Notice the boat being darker in the foreground and the boats behind it getting lighter. Also- the movement this painting belongs to is Impressionism, why do you think it is called that? The painting captures an impression- or idea of the moment. The style can be described as loose and sketchy. Brushstrokes are visible.

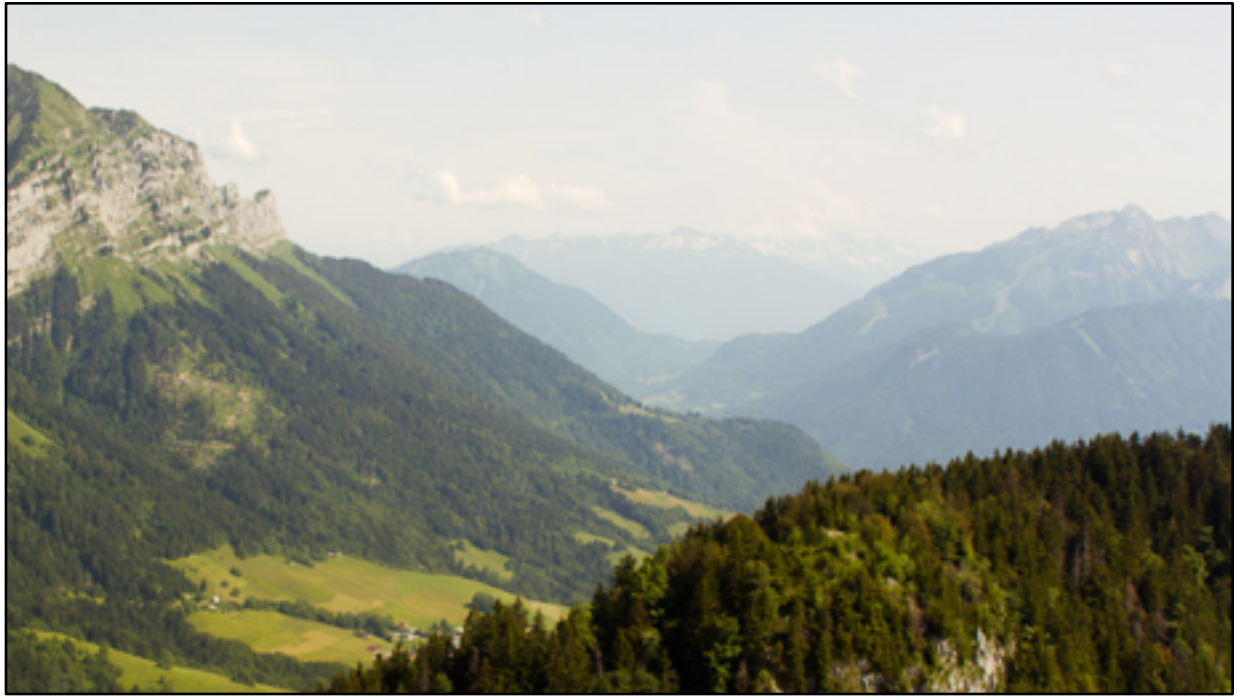

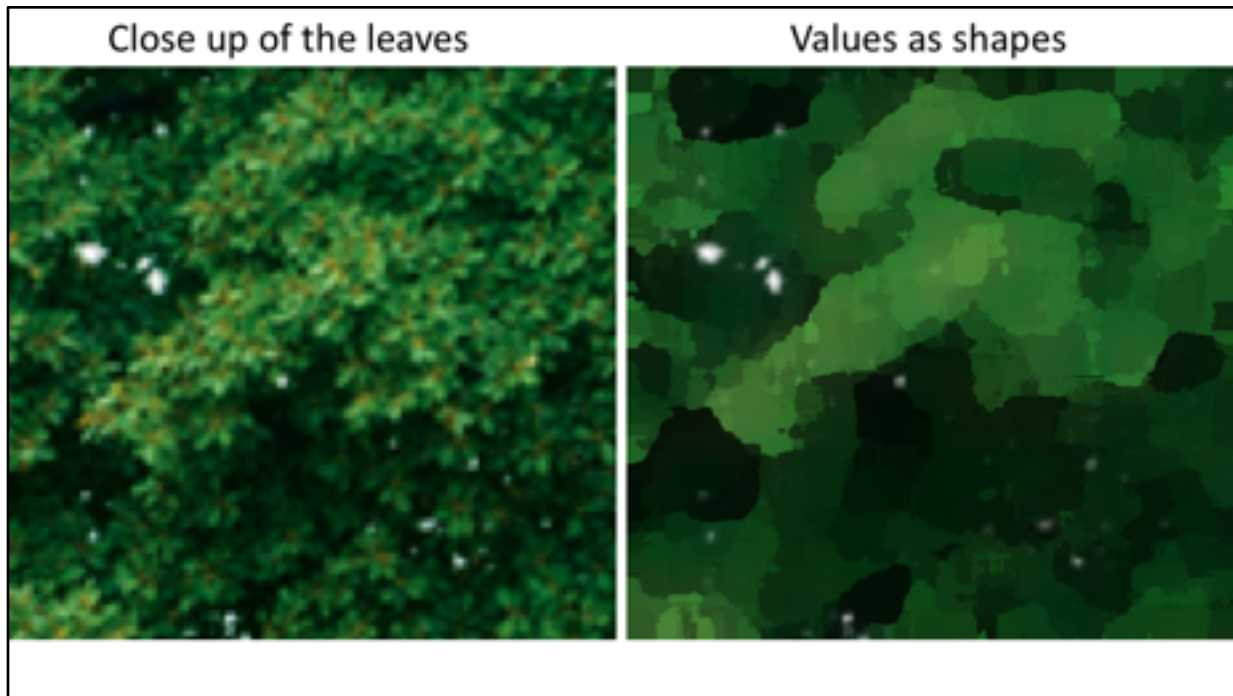

- One will be a charcoal drawing
- One will be a black and white painting
- One will be painted in color



Assessment

- Engaging/dynamic composition
- Color mixing, Intensity Changes (only for the colored painting)
- How the paint was handled
- Depth was achieved through the use of atmospheric perspective (lighter in background, darker in foreground, smaller objects in background, more focused in foreground)
- Brushstrokes or lines help define the plane they are depicting.
