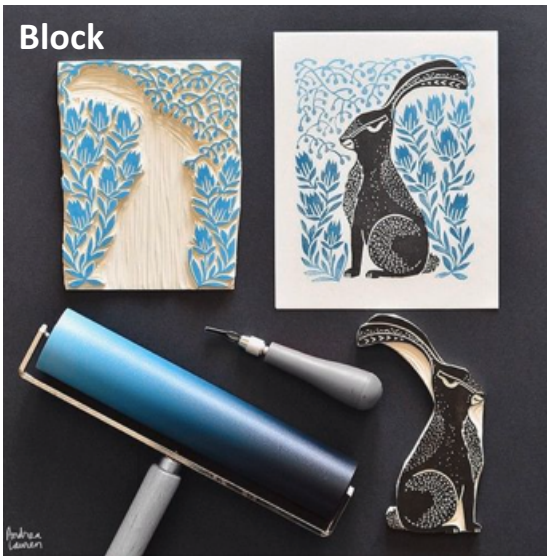

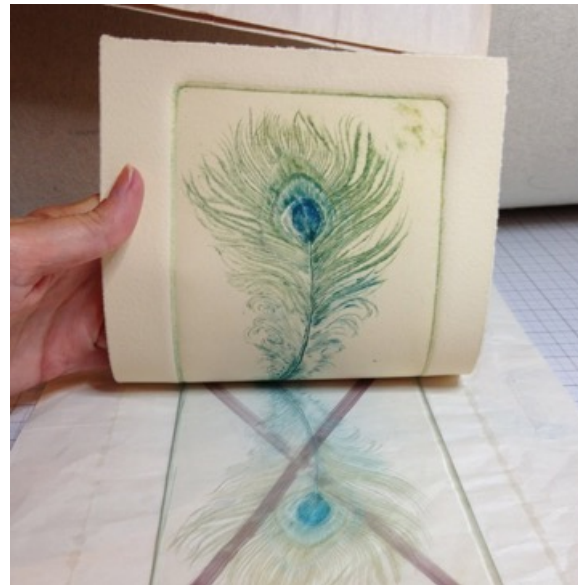
# What is printmaking?

- A way of making art by transferring an image to paper with a block, plate, stone or screen

Block



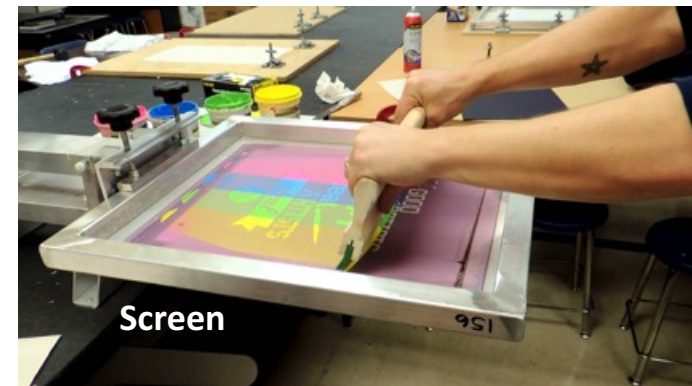
Plate

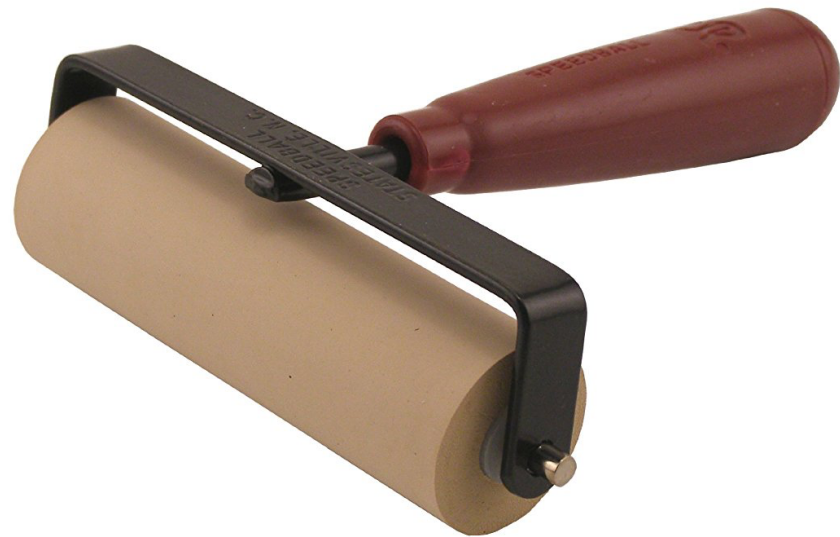

# Printing block



## Step 2

- Trace my Notan image onto tracing paper WITH A PENCIL
- *This needs to be dark*

## Step 3

- Transfer the pencil drawing onto the printing block
- *The pencil lead needs to be touching the block*
- *Hold it VERY still during this process*

## Step 4

- Go over pencil lines with a fine-point sharpie

# Print Vocabulary

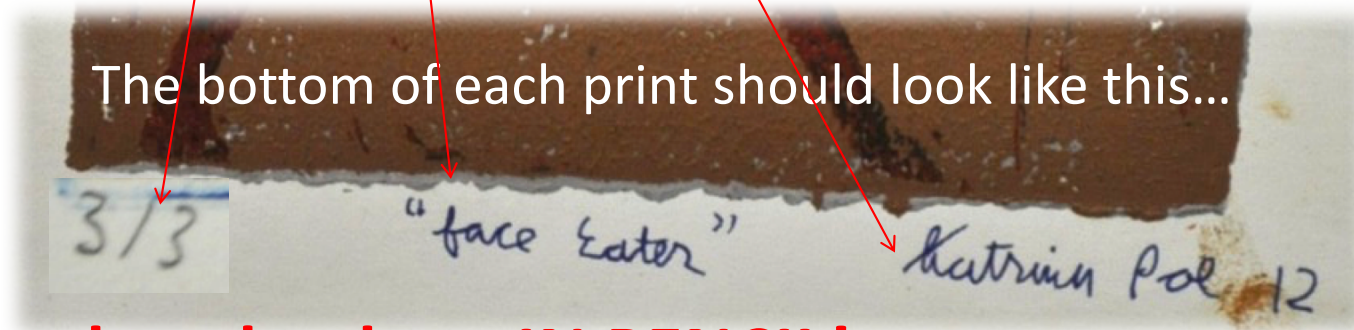


- **What is a reduction print?**
- **multicolor print in which the separate colors are printed from the same block at different stages, lightest color FIRST**

You must do a **test print** with **black ink** onto **newsprint** BEFORE I give you're your final printing paper!
